*Must be able to work Friday and Saturday nights from 6pm-1am.* Ideal candidates will want to learn to bartend and spend just 1-year in this role before transitioning to a bartender.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

#### **Job Requirements:**

- Upbeat personality and professional image, maintains positive attitude with patrons and team, engaging customers in conversation
- Check Customers' identification ensuring they are of legal drinking age.
- Ensures a safe working environment for all employees within the bar
- Always maintains a clean bar and sanitary conditions
- Maintain neat, clean, and organized bar area according to restaurant specifications; prep and stock bar (e.g., juices, fruit, beer, etc.), clean glassware, check restrooms, fill ice, and after-hours cleaning, mopping, and removal of bar floor mats.
- Recognizes and addresses potential intoxicated, disruptive, or undesirable guests
- Properly handles, reports and documents associate and guest accidents & injuries
- Move throughout facility, kitchen, and bathroom areas to visually monitor and take action to ensure cleanliness and organization.
- When making Pizza, ensures food quality standards are complied with and that all health and quality procedures are consistently applied.
- Assist with some drinks – generally just beers (when bartender is busy)
- Generally, provides support to the bartender throughout the shift as needed.

#### **Additional Requirements:**

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Excellent reading and oral proficiency of the English language
- Basic math skills – ability to make correct change, etc.
- High School Diploma or equivalent required – additional education is a plus
- Computer literate – Ability to use POS

- This position is subject to irregular hours to include late nights, weekends and holidays, candidates must be flexible to work when business needs warrant. Hours vary from the summer season (peak) to the winter season (off-season).

**Working Conditions:**

- 100% Public interaction and conversation.
- 100% Walk and stand (for up to 5 hours at a time).
- 75% Reach, bend, stoop, lift and wipe.
- 10% Operate Point-of-Sale system and make correct change.
- 50% Lift and move 40-pound cases and ice about 10 times per shift and carry 20 yards.
- 20% Teams lift and move kegs up to 100-pounds.

**Training Requirements:**

- Successful completion and passage of alcohol certification (bartenders license), ability to recertify every 2 years or as needed *if employee begins to bartend.*
